Voter guides

The city of St. Louis is buying 140 Palm Pilots and a three-year subscription to Miken Voter software from Miken Technologies to help voters find the correct polling places. Active and inactive voter registration information, as well as a street guide, is loaded onto the Palm Pilots. The information will help election officials direct voters to the proper polling places. That contract and another with Greene County, Mo., are expected to add more than \$100,000 to Miken's revenue, said Martin White, senior account manager. The St. Louis company also is talking to election officials in St. Louis County, Cook County, Ill., and in Florida.
